#### **4.2 Sycamore Tree update**

The Chairman reported the results of the survey. The tree is a Norwegian Maple. The instruction is to cut down the tree. The tree is in a conservation area; however Northern Power Grid do have dispensation to remove if it is a danger to the electricity lines. They visited on the 23<sup>rd of</sup> August and felt there was no immediate danger to the line but will schedule its removal. #### 5.1 Architect, plans, scheduling update.
